Five Iowa teachers have been named finalists in the Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST).

The two math finalists are:

[Rick Brooks](#), a math teacher at Johnston High School, Johnston Community School District

[Curtis Martinek](#), a math teacher at Gilbert High School, Gilbert Community School District

The three science finalists are:

[Lynne Bleeker](#), a seventh-grade science teacher at Parkview Middle School, Ankeny Community School District

[Shannon Harrison McLaughlin](#), a science teacher at Norwalk High School, Norwalk Community School District

[Alicia D. Schiller](#), a science teacher at Central Lee High School, Central Lee Community School District (Donnellson)

The Iowa finalists' applications have been submitted to the national selection committee. Two award-winners may be selected to represent Iowa. Award-winners receive \$10,000 and a trip to Washington, D.C., where they will participate in recognition events and professional development programs.

"The talent and commitment shown by these teachers is inspiring," said Iowa Department of Education Director Ryan Wise. "They will help lead the way as Iowa grows its commitment to science, technology, engineering and mathematics education."

The Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching are the nation's highest honors specifically for kindergarten through 12th grade teachers of math and science.

More than 4,300 teachers have been recognized since Congress established the program in 1983. The National Science Foundation administers the awards on behalf of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy.

Awards are given to math and science teachers from each of the 50 states and four U.S. jurisdictions. The program recognizes those teachers who develop and implement a high-quality instructional program that is informed by content knowledge and enhances student learning. Awards alternate annually between elementary and secondary teachers.
