

GRADING SYSTEMS

High School Grading Policies:

Grading policies and procedures for high school courses will be established by each instructor and explained to the students at the beginning of each course. All grading policies and procedures will be monitored by building administration.

The High School grading scale and values for calculating GPA are as follows:

A+ 100%-99% (4.0) A 98%-93% (4.0) A- 90%-92% (3.67)

B+ 87%-89% (3.33) B 83%-86% (3.0) B- 80%- 82% (2.67)

C+ 77%-79% (2.33) C 73%-76% (2.0) C- 70-72% (1.67)

D+ 67%-69% (1.33) D 63%-66% (1.0) D- 60%-62% (0.67)

F 59% and below (0.00).

Pass (P) = 60% and above, Failure = 59% and below

Honor Roll will be awarded at the conclusion of each semester. Students receiving letter grades in the minimum required courses with the exception of Band and Choir will be honored. The regular Honor Roll is for a semester GPA of 3.00- 3.66 and the High Honor Roll is for a semester GPA of 3.67-4.00.

Middle School Grading Policies:

Grading policies and procedures for students' grades will be established by each instructor and explained to the students at the beginning of each course. Gilbert Middle School uses a standards-referenced grading system where assessments are scored on a 3-point scale (3 - Proficient, 2 - Developing, 1 - Beginning, 0 - No Evidence).
