Parents & Staff,

We are getting ready to start the twelfth day of school tomorrow. Thank you for helping to make this a smooth transition. There have been a few questions on how it is decided who quarantines. Once a positive COVID-19 case is identified, the district begins to contact trace in consultation with Story County Public Health. The tracing involves identifying the students who are close contacts. Close contact is someone who has been within six feet of the positive individual for more than 15 minutes. This is done through seating charts, etc.

Families impacted will:

- Receive a personal call from the district.
- Receive a personal call from Story County Public Health.
