Our Board met last evening to discuss and act on Senate File 160, which addresses onsite and remote learning options for districts. The decision was made to move to a 5 day school week for our onsite learners starting February 17th. What does this mean for our students and staff?

- Wednesday, February 3rd & 10th are still remote learning days for **ALL** students
- Starting Wednesday, February 17th, **onsite** students will no longer have remote learning Wednesdays for the rest of the school year. School will be in session and follow a 12:30 dismissal schedule
  - 12:20 for Intermediate, Middle School, & High School students
  - 12:30 for Elementary students
- Remote learners will continue to work all 5 days of the school week
  - Teachers will continue to have office hours

Families have the option for fully onsite or fully remote. We are assuming that if your child is on-site, they will continue on-site. If your child is remote, they will continue to work remotely.
